Dagger Diving Services was founded in 2017 with the intention of improving the standard of service and quality in the industry, as identified by a number of divers.

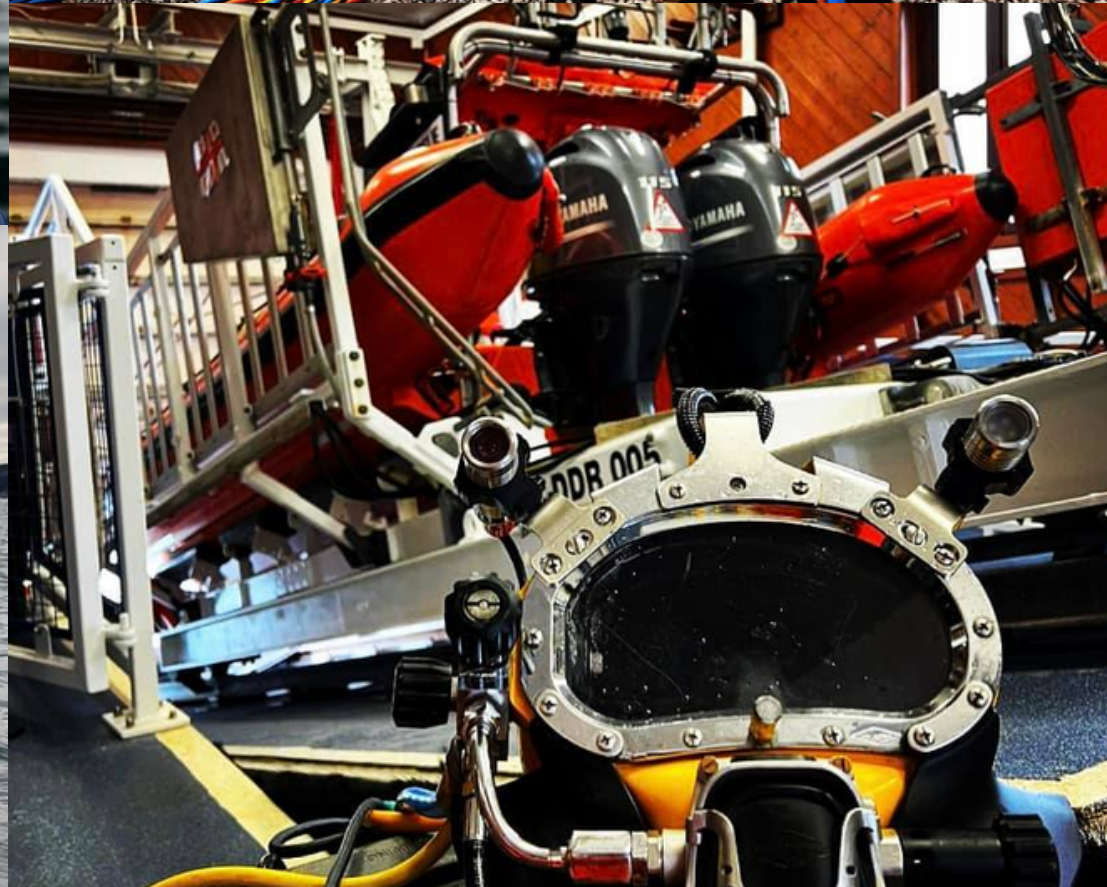

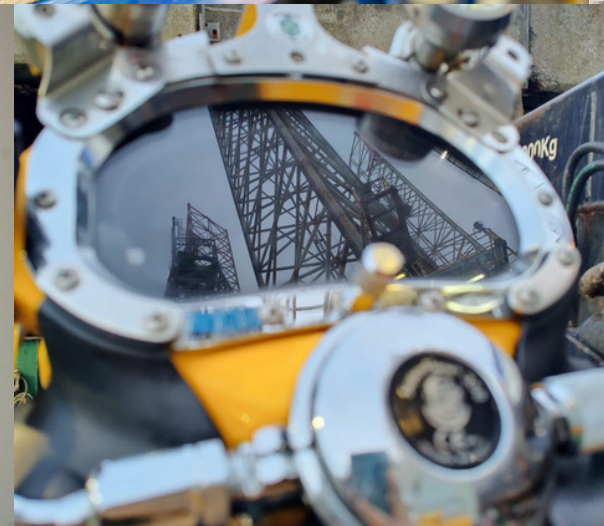
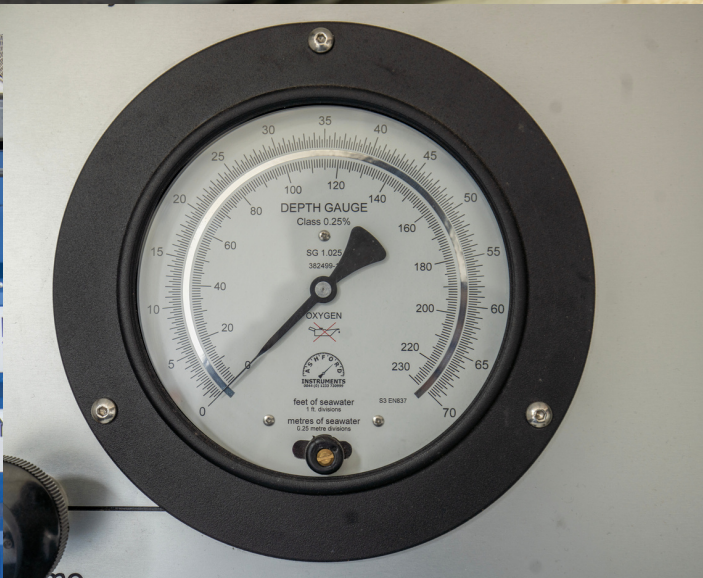

## Objective n° 1

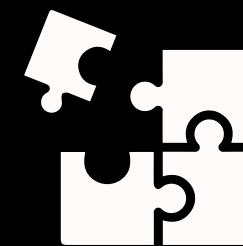
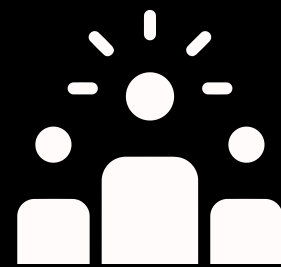

# BRAMLEY MOORE DOCK UXO CLEARANCE

THE DIVING PROJECT AT BRAMLEY MOORE DOCK WAS A DEFINING MOMENT IN DAGGER DIVING SERVICES' HISTORY. IT MARKED THE COMPANY'S ASCENT INTO LARGER, MORE COMPLEX OPERATIONS, ITS EXPERTISE IN UXO DIVING, THE INTRODUCTION OF SCAFF FLOAT TECHNOLOGY, AND THE SUCCESSFUL MANAGEMENT OF MULTIPLE TEAMS, WITH UP TO 32 DIVERS BEING MANAGED AT ONCE. THE PROJECT DEMONSTRATED DAGGER DIVING SERVICES' COMMITMENT AND DETERMINATION TO INNOVATE AND SET NEW STANDARDS WHILE GETTING THE JOB DONE. THE TEAM CARRIED OUT A CIRCULAR DX300 SEARCH TO IDENTIFY SURFACE AND BURIED FERROUS ANOMALIES WITH SIMULTANEOUS VISUAL/TACTILE INVESTIGATION OF SURFACE TARGETS.

# AVENTUS ENERGY - SHELF FORTRESS UWILD

The Diving Project at Shelf Fortress aimed to complete an UWILD inspection of the underwater assets, including anodes and structural welds.

- UWILD inspections are a crucial aspect of maritime safety and maintenance, as they help identify and address potential problems before they escalate into costly and potentially dangerous issues. Regular UWILD inspections are a part of a ship's overall maintenance and safety management program, ensuring that vessels remain seaworthy and in compliance with industry regulations.
- This project demonstrated our access to a highly qualified dive team capable of conducting inspections to a high standard.





# NKT-WEISDALE VOE - CABLE BURIAL

DAGGER DIVING SERVICES LTD UNDERTOOK A SIGNIFICANT AND PIONEERING PROJECT FOR NKT, INVOLVING CABLE BURIAL AT WEISDALE VOE. THIS PROJECT MARKED A PIVOTAL MOMENT FOR DAGGER DIVING SERVICES LTD AS IT WAS THE FIRST TIME THE COMPANY IMPLEMENTED THE DO23 DIVING STANDARD FOR MAINTENANCE, ALONG WITH IN-DEPTH HAZARD IDENTIFICATION RISK ASSESSMENTS (HIRA), IN CLOSE COLLABORATION WITH OUR CLIENT, NKT. THE PROJECT PRESENTED SEVERAL CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR US AND ALLOWED FOR VALUABLE LEARNING EXPERIENCES. THIS PROJECT ENCOMPASSED A LARGE MOBILIZATION EFFORT FROM SEAHAM HARBOUR, FOLLOWED BY SAILING THE EQUIPMENT UP TO WEISDALE VOE FOR THE CABLE BURIAL WORK. IT ALSO INVOLVED MULTIPLE AUDITS CONDUCTED BY THE CLIENT AND EXTERNAL PARTIES TO ENSURE ADHERENCE TO SAFETY AND QUALITY STANDARDS. IT SHOWCASED OUR COMMITMENT TO SAFETY, ADHERENCE TO INDUSTRY STANDARDS, AND ABILITY TO HANDLE COMPLEX LOGISTICAL CHALLENGES. THE PROJECT ALLOWED THE ORGANIZATION TO LEARN AND GROW, REINFORCING OUR POSITION AS A RELIABLE PARTNER FOR CLIENTS IN THE DIVING AND SUBSEA SERVICES INDUSTRY
